Overview

Day 1: March, 31st / Arrival - Welcome to Egypt

Welcome to Egypt! You'll be met and assisted by a Tour representative at the Cairo airport and then you will be escorted by Tour staff to the Mena House Pyramids hotel. **Welcome Gathering in the evening**

Overnight Cairo: Mena House Pyramids

Meals: Dinner at Hotel

Day 2: April, 1st / Great Pyramids, Sphinx, Sakkara and Memphis

At 05:30am we have a private time inside to **the Great Pyramid King's Chamber and Queen's Chamber** from 06:00 till 08:00am. After breakfast we will visit the last remaining Wonder of the Ancient World: **the Great Pyramids** and **the Sphinx**. After lunch we will visit **Memphis** and **Sakkara**. Then back to hotel and have your Dinner.

Overnight Cairo: Mena House Pyramids

Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Day 3: April 2nd / Alabaster Mosque and the Cairo Museum to see the treasure of Egypt including the treasures of King Tutankhamen

After breakfast we will go to the **Cairo Egyptian Museum**. This museum contains many important pieces of ancient Egyptian history and houses the world's largest collection of Pharaonic antiquities. This includes many treasures from the tomb of King Tutankhamen. After lunch we will visit the great **Mosque of Muhammad Ali Pasha**, or **Alabaster Mosque**. Situated on the summit of a centuries-old citadel, this is a fine example of an Ottoman-era mosque.

Day 4: April 3rd / Hanging Church and fly to Luxor

After Breakfast we will go to **The Hanging Church** (Virgin Mary's Coptic Orthodox) and **Abu Serga Church** (Saints Sergius and Bacchus) This church is traditionally believed to have been built on the spot where the Holy Family (Joseph, Mary and the infant Jesus), rested at the end of their journey into Egypt. They may also have lived in the area while Joseph worked at the fortress. Then Afternoon Depart to Luxor by flight. temple of Mentuhotep II.

Day 5: April 4th / Valley of the Kings and Hatshepsut Temple

After breakfast start your journey to the **Valley of the Kings**, also called the Valley of the Gates of the Kings. For a period of nearly 500 years, from the 16th to 11th century BC, tombs were constructed there for the Pharaohs and powerful nobles of the New Kingdom. The valley stands on the west bank of the Nile, opposite Thebes (modern Luxor), within the heart of the Theban Necropolis. Afterwards we will visit the **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**. This mortuary temple is dedicated to the sun god Amon-Ra and is located next to the mortuary. Then enjoy a **Felucca** ride on the Nile River.

Day 6: April 5th / Hathor Temple at Dendara and Luxor Temple

After breakfast we will travel by bus to **Dendara Temple**. It is one of the best-preserved temple complexes in Egypt and contains the Temple of Hathor. Evening we will visit the **Luxor Temple**. This is a large ancient temple complex, located on the east bank of the Nile River, and was founded in 1400 BCE. After touring the temple we head back to the hotel.

Day : April 6th / Karnak Temple and Luxor Museum

After breakfast we will visit **The Karnak Temple**. The temple complex has four parts. The most commonly visited one is the Precinct of Amun-Ra. In addition to this precinct we will visit the three other parts: the Precinct of Mut, the Precinct of Montu, and the ruins of the Temple of Amenhotep IV (more commonly known as Ankhnesneferibre) The Karnak temple, especially that dedicated to Amun-Ra, is a wonderful example of the Hypostyle Hall architectural style. Afternoon a visit to **Luxor Museum**. Following the Museum and lunch return to the hotel.

Overnight Aswan: Maritim Jolie Ville Hotel

Day 8: April 7th / Kom Ombo and Edfu Temples

Breakfast in Luxor hotel then drive to Aswan with stops on the way to visit **Edfu Temple** the falcon God Horus and **Kom Ombo Temple** the temple of the crocodile God Sobek, Then continue driving to Aswan upon arrival check in your hotel and overnight.

Overnight Aswan: Movenpick Resort

Day 9: April 8th / Abu Simbel Temples and Nubian Village

After breakfast we will depart by bus for **Abu Simbel**. The two temples in Abu Simbel complex were carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen Nefertari. Then we will return to Aswan. Afternoon enjoy a tour by motorboat to the **Nubian Village** and Camel Ride on the desert.

Overnight Aswan: Movenpick Resort Aswan

Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner



Day 10: April 9th / Philae Temple (Isis Temple) / Fly to Cairo

After breakfast we will visit **Philae Temple**. It was dedicated to the goddess Isis, the wife of Osiris and mother of Horus. These three characters are very important in ancient Egyptian life, culture and art. Then our staff will transfer you to Aswan airport and takes your flight to Cairo upon arrival transfers to your hotel and overnight.

Overnight Cairo: Mena House Hotel.

Meals: Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Day 11: April 10th / Final Departure

After breakfast our tour staff will transfer you to the Cairo Airport and assist you for the final departure from Egypt, with memories to last a **lifetime!**
